This document is a Summary of Material Modifications ("SMM") intended to notify you of important changes to allowances for crowns and abutments on all dental implant procedures and coverage for the Invisalign orthodontic treatment available under the Health and Benefit Trust Fund of the International Union of Operating Engineers Local Union 94-94A-94B, AFL-CIO ("Plan" or "Fund"). Generally speaking, these changes, as discussed in greater detail below, are effective as of January 1, 2017. This summary is intended to satisfy the requirements for issuance of an SMM under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended ("ERISA"). #### **Dental Implants:**

Effective January 1, 2017, the allowance for a crown and/or abutment on all dental implant procedures has been increased \$150. The dental allowance for the surgical placement of implant body, code D6010, remains the same.

The Fund's dental provider, Sele-Dent, Inc. ("Sele-Dent") has sent notification to all participating Local 94 Network dental providers about these changes. In addition, Sele-Dent has informed all participating Local 94 Network dental providers who perform implant services about their contractual obligation to accept the following allowances for the Plan's dental implant procedure codes and not to charge participants more than the applicable co-payments for such procedures. In order to enforce these policies, each participating Local 94 Network provider who performs implant services has been asked to agree in writing to continue accepting the Fund's fee schedule, as modified with these benefit enhancements. If the dentist does not accept these terms for implant services, he/she will no longer be a participating Local 94 Network provider for implant services effective January 1, 2017. Enclosed is a list of all the Local 94 Network dentists who perform dental implants.

#### **Orthodontic Benefit:**

Effective January 1, 2017, the Invisalign method for corrective orthodontics (as approved by the American Dental Association) is now a covered treatment under the existing orthodontic lifetime maximum of \$2,154. Please note this is a more expensive method of treatment than traditional orthodontic brackets; therefore the Local 94 Network orthodontists and the Sele-Dent PPO orthodontists do not have to accept the orthodontic lifetime maximum of \$2,154 for the Invisalign treatment as payment in full. However, you now have the option to choose this treatment as a covered benefit with the Plan covering up to \$2,154 of the costs for the Invisalign method. For this reason, it is important that you confirm with your orthodontist whether they will accept this amount as payment in full for such benefits or if they will charge a higher amount and bill you for the balance.

As a reminder, Local 94 Network orthodontists accept the \$2,154 as payment in full for traditional orthodontic services. Additionally, Sele-Dent does have a separate orthodontic network. However, this network requires co-payments. Enclosed is a list of the preferred Sele-Dent orthodontists who will perform all traditional orthodontic services (excluding Invisalign) for a total patient co-payment of \$1,046.

#### Reminders:

Remember all dental services over \$500, all dental implants, and all orthodontia services must be pre-approved by Sele-Dent. Prior approval is necessary even if your dental provider is a participating dental provider in Local 94's Network, Sele-Dent's Network, or Out of Network provider. The current Individual Calendar Year Maximum remains \$2,500, and the Lifetime Orthodontic Maximum remains \$2,154. If you visit a Sele-Dent PPO dentist, or an Out-of-Network dentist for dental implants, you will be responsible for fees in excess of the Local 94 Plan's Fee Schedule. Enclosed is a list of all the Local 94 Network dentists who perform dental implants.

This SMM is intended to provide you with an easy-to-understand description of certain changes to the Plan. While every effort has been made to make this description as complete and as accurate as possible, this SMM, of course, cannot contain a full restatement of the terms and provisions of the Plan. If any conflict should arise between this SMM and the Plan, or if any point is not discussed in this SMM or is only partially discussed, the terms of the Plan will govern in all cases.

The Board of Trustees or its duly authorized designee, reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to amend, modify or terminate the Plan, or any benefits provided under the Plan, in whole or in part, at any time and for any reason, in accordance with the applicable amendment procedures established under the Plan and the Agreement and Declaration of Trust establishing the Plan (the "Trust Agreement"). The Trust Agreement is available at the Fund Office and may be inspected by you free of charge during normal business hours.

No individual other than the Board of Trustees (or its duly authorized designee) has any authority to interpret the plan documents, make any promises to you about benefits under the Plan, or to change any provision of the Plan. Only the Board of Trustees (or its duly authorized designee) has the exclusive right and power, in its sole and absolute discretion, to interpret the terms of the Plan and decide all matters arising under the Plan.

#### IMPORTANT GOVERNMENT NOTICE REGARDING THE PLAN'S GRANDFATHERED PLAN STATUS

As of the date of this Notice, the Trustees believe that the Fund is a "grandfathered plan" as such term is defined under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 (more commonly known as Health Care Reform). As permitted by Health Care Reform, a grandfathered health plan can preserve certain basic health coverage that was already in effect when Health Care Reform was enacted. Being a grandfathered health plan means that the medical coverage that you have elected under the plan may not include certain consumer protections of Health Care Reform that apply to other group health plans, for example, the requirement for the provision of preventive health services without any cost sharing (i.e., copayments, coinsurance, deductibles). However, grandfathered health plans must comply with certain other consumer protections in the Affordable Care Act, for example, the elimination of lifetime limits on benefits and extension of coverage to dependents until age 26. ## Local 94 Network Dentists who perform Dental Implants and have agreed to accept the Fund's fee schedule for implants effective 1/1/17.

Dental implants are covered procedures when they are approved by Sele-Dent and services are rendered by a Local 94 Network dental provider. If you visit a Sele-Dent or an Out-of-Network dental provider for implants, or a Local 94 Network dentist who has not agreed to accept the Fund's fee schedule for implants you will be responsible for fees in excess of the Local 94 Fee Schedule.
